## Announcement of Fellowship for Building Leadership in Atmospheric Environment and Air Quality Management in East Asia in 2025

In line with the Work Programme and Budget of the Acid Deposition Monitoring Network in East Asia (EANET) in 2025, which was approved at the Twenty-sixth Session of the Intergovernmental Meeting (IG26) on the EANET, the Network Center for the EANET (NC) in collaboration with the Fudan University, China, is implementing the EANET project, the "Fellowship for Building Leadership in Atmospheric Environment and Air Quality Management in East Asia" (Fellowship Program). Therefore, the NC and the Fudan University are now inviting applications from the EANET Participating Countries to participate in this Fellowship Program.

Please note that the information on the program of this project is currently under consideration. We would like to inform you soon when the program is fixed. Please also kindly note that this program replaces the "EANET Research Fellowship Program" conducted until 2023.

Participants will be selected to take part in the Fellowship Program for 6 months in 2025 including the intensive on-site research at Fudan University, Shanghai, China and the NC for the EANET, Japan, respectively. During the program, the participants will report and discuss their progress with the designated supervisors in China and Japan via on-line and off-line through monthly online meetings and intensive on-site training.

The theme is limited within the scope of EANET, including

> Air quality monitoring;

> Data analysis;

> Methodology development on simulation and modeling, emission inventory, health

impact and others;

> Environmental policy and its evaluation; and

Risk management and/or cost-benefit analysis.

It would be highly appreciated if the NFPs, along with the SAC members, Heads of National

Centers, and QA/QC Managers would inform related agencies and/or research institutes in your

countries and encourage the junior and/or middle-level government officials and researchers,

who are currently/ or will be involved in EANET.

The Application Form (Annex 1) and the Potential List of Research Themes (Annex 2) are

attached. The completed application form should be submitted through the NFPs to the NC by <u>14</u> <u>February 2025</u>. Please also note that despite how many applicants are nominated from each

Participating Country, in the principle of fairness, participants will be selected from each different

EANET Participating Country, except for special circumstances.
